Dear Friends,

I always pay close attention to the day a person dies in the light of the Saints who have gone before us, and our Late Queen surrendered her spirit to her Lord and our God on the day when the Church celebrates the Birth of the Blessed Virgin Mary where on that day we pray, 'Pray for us Holy Mary Mother of God, that we may be worthy of the promises of Christ.'

Our Blessed Mother and our Late Queen have much in common and I believe they will get on exceedingly well!

Just as Mary said to Gabriel, "Behold the maidservant of the Lord! Let it be to me according to your word," entrusting herself to God in bearing the Saviour of the World, the Mother of God & the Church, as well as for some Christians Queen of heaven.

I was reminded shortly after the Queen died that when someone very close to us dies, the trial can go so far as to undermine our hope, especially when the Queen offered so much stability in the midst of instability over her reign.

Rediscovering the trusting of faith and peace of heart sometimes requires having a great deal of patience with ourselves, which the Queen had in abundance. When we need to be comforted, Christ sends the Holy Spirit, the Comforter. And the pain of a separation can be transfigured into a communion that is at one and the same time so mysterious and so indispensable. This was summed up by the Queen in these words: 'For me the life of Jesus Christ, the prince of peace...is an inspiration and an anchor in my life.'

As much as we mourn the loss of our beloved Queen and the stability, she has given us over her 70-year reign, we hold steadfast that the Crown endures and the very best of the old reign has been taken into the new with the Late Queen's Son, King Charles the Second. This, for me has taken out some of the sting of instability I felt when the Queen passed and the stability that I have felt after being able to witness on TV for the first time the Accession Rites & Declarations as well as the way he has conducted himself throughout these days of mourning and into the early days of the King's new Reign.

I also have the added confidence and comfort in this harvest season that the harvest has been gathered in for our beloved Queen Elizabeth, the journey ended, the story told, life's tasks finished and neatly bound like a sheaf of wheat. There is and was a roundedness about Her Majesty's life, a sense of completion and fulfilment that she so richly deserved.

May our beloved Queen Elizabeth rest in peace & May God save the King!

#### FLU & COVID VACCINATION PROGRAMME - AUTUMN/WINTER 2022

Dear All,

We are now making our way fast into Autumn and as the leaves start falling it signals that it's time for the Autumn Vaccinations.

#### **COVID and Flu Vaccines**

This year we will be providing Flu and COVID vaccines in large clinics based in William Brookes School. These vaccines will be delivered together as advised by the JCVI. For anyone wishing to have the vaccinations separately, this will be provided towards the end of the campaign in designated clinics. We will be using the Moderna Bivalent vaccine for all those aged 18 years or over, which has action against the Omicron COVID variant. The only exceptions will be those under 18 years of age who will require a Paediatric Dose of Pfizer, and those with true vaccine allergies, who will need referring to a designated clinic in Secondary Care. By the time of reading this some of you may have been contacted by us to book your vaccine, or even had them done. Our vaccine clinic timings are limited by the delivery dates of our vaccines which are beyond our control. We are however endeavouring to hold clinics as soon as possible after each delivery.

For any patients who are unable to leave their house we will be doing house-bound vaccines, but we ask that anyone able to leave their home attends a clinic and we will facilitate vaccinations as needed. Our reception team will be contacting those patients who are known to be housebound, however if you are concerned we may not be aware of your circumstances please speak with our reception team. We are lucky to have a very community minded patient population, so if any of you aren't sure about a neighbour of friend, please ask them and help them out.

#### **Shingles and Pneumonia Vaccines**

Previously we have given these at the same time as Flu, however the Pneumonia and Shingles vaccines will now be given in dedicated clinics in the surgery which are being organised by our nursing team. If you are due one of these and not heard from us, then please contact the surgery and our reception team will be able to help.

#### **Communications**

We are aware that you are keen to know about these clinics and are going to do our upmost to communicate this across as many platforms as possible. This will include texting, Facebook, the practice website, the surgeries and local areas and shops. The best way to ensure you hear as soon as possible is to check we have the correct phone numbers and email for you. We will do

#### Staff News

It is with great sadness that our long serving Senior Partner and much-loved GP, Dr Bailey will be retiring from the Practice on 31st October 2022. Dr Bailey has been with the Practice for over 25 years and will be sorely missed by patients and the team at Much Wenlock and Cressage Medical Practice. We hope that all our patients will join the team at Much Wenlock and Cressage Medical Practice in wishing Dr Bailey all the very best in her retirement. During September and October there will be a comments book available at both Practices for patients to leave messages for Dr Bailey should they wish to do so.

#### First Contact Practitioner appointments available now

Patients can now access a First Contact Practitioner through the Practice. The First Point Practitioner is an expertly trained Physiotherapist who can assess your condition and advise any short-term treatments, suggest things that may help and, if appropriate, refer onwards to our local Physiotherapy department if you may need a course of treatment, or to our Musculoskeletal Clinic.

It is important to know that they are working remotely so this assessment will be over the telephone or video link.

If you were thinking of calling to speak to a GP for the first time about a back or joint problem or something similar that is bothering you, this may be good alternative. Please speak to a member of our reception team if you would like to book your appointment with the First Contact Practitioner.

#### **Mental Health Practitioner Appointments**

We are able offer patients face to face appointments with a Mental Health Practitioner at the Practice. Patients with anxiety or depression and who are not currently being treated by a mental health practitioner, can book in for an initial appointment. The nurse is also able to see patients who are on the waiting list for mental health services but have not yet been seen. Please contact a member of our reception team if you would like an appointment with our Mental Health Practitioner. Appointments are available on alternate Thursdays at Cressage.

#### Patient Online Access - Update to Services

From October 2022 there will be the facility for patients to book routine Doctors' appointments via Patient Online Access. Patients can book face to

face appointment slots or telephone consultations slots online as well as by phone. Please note that when selecting telephone consultations that the location shown refers to where the clinician is based, and patients should not attend the surgery but await a phone call.

Patients with Patient Online Access can also continue to:

- · Order repeat medication
- · View a summary of your medical records, including immunisation history

**ASK THE POD** – you asked the questions, the Prescription Ordering Direct Service answered.....

Q1) As I travel often and am out of the UK for three or four weeks at a time I find it almost impossible to plan my prescription ordering from the new POD service.

The POD service can provide a holiday issue request of up to 3 months which is usually sufficient to cover most holidays/travel out of the country. All requests for holiday issues are sent to the Practice who have the final decision as to whether this is an appropriate request. POD will ask for your departure and return dates and how much current supply you have. With this information they are able to work how much of an additional supply you would need to cover you holiday and enough for your return to be able to place a routine request.

Q2) POD will not issue prescription's unless you have seven days or less medication and I imagine this must cause problems for a lot of people.

The seven day rule has been agreed between Practice and POD to reduce potential wastage, avoid patients having excess medication in their homes and to help reduce the effects of supply chain issues. As stated above POD will issue up to 3 months medication, subject to approval from the Practice, if there is a need such as a holiday request. There can be some leeway, in exceptional circumstances, to allow ordering up to 10 days in advance.

Q3) The ordering of repeat prescription when you only have 7 days of medication remaining is not long enough. Experience shows it can take anything up to 4 days to place order and 4 days to dispense.

Seven days allows 48 hours for the GP practice to authorise the prescriptions and 48 hours for the Pharmacy/Dispensary to dispense the medication which should be sufficient time.

College to take part in some great sound wave experiments to help their physics understanding. All this, and getting back into normal everyday routines, welcoming new children, and new members of staff.





#### CRESSAGE VILLAGE HALL

An underground stream should run through the back gardens of Ashdale Road, under Severn Way, by the Under 11s Play Ground, under the Village Hall, through the Old Hall gardens and into the river but currently it doesn't. It does get as far as the Village Hall and then it stops because sometime ago the pipe collapsed and the water has been collecting under the floor of the hall. This was undetected until the wooden floor became a bit like a trampoline and further investigation showed that the timbers under the floor had started to collapse. At that point the Village Hall Committee decided that the hall must close until the problem had been rectified. As you would expect the hall is adequately covered by insurance but the insurance company, as they always do, tried to wriggle out of their responsibility.

Marie Instan who is the Chair of the Committee has spent an enormous amount of time trying to get the insurance company to accept full

responsibility but alas they will only accept responsibility for replacing the floor, not for replacing the pipework under the hall because the pipe does not service the hall. Before we can start work on the floor, which will be paid for, we must replace the pipework and then the flow of water will resume to the Old Hall Pool and into the river.

The Committee needs to raise money for this work to be done so we are appealing to all of you to help us. The sooner we can get the floor sorted the sooner we can re-open and all the many users from the Gardening Club, the Tuesday Talks, WI, Bingo and various private bookings can use it once more.

Financially times are difficult for many and I would not expect every one to be in a position to help but if you can go to: GoFundMe.com and search 'Help Cressage Village Hall' and Donateonline. If you do not have internet access then you can make a cheque to Cressage Village Hall Committee. If you can donate through GoFundMe and you are a tax payer then we can receive the tax relief thus increasing considerably your donation. villagers gave generously and we are asking the same again. Sadly those who were so generous in the 70s have now passed away but some of you will remember Dr Robertson, who was also a trustee, Col Thornycroft, also a trustee, from the Mount, Mr. & Mrs. Hart from the Crown House, Mrs. Binney from the Lodge, Mr. & Mrs. Foster from the Station House and of course Mrs. Link from the Old School House.

We do need your help if we are to restore our Village Hall to full use again Thank you, Brian Oakley
